12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-103, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 1-103. A. 1. There is hereby created the State Board
16	of Health, which shall be an advisory body to the State Commissioner
17	of Health and shall consist of nine (9) members appointed by the
18	Governor and confirmed by the Senate for regular terms of nine (9)
19	years, except as hereinafter otherwise indicated. Effective January
20	14, 2019, all duties and powers of the Board shall be transferred to
21	the Commissioner. Any provision in statute that provides to the
22	Board authority that is not advisory in nature shall be deemed to
23	grant the duty or power to the Commissioner.
24	

- 2. Not less than four members shall hold a current license to practice medicine in this state pursuant to the Oklahoma Allopathic Medical and Surgical Licensure and Supervision Act and the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act. At least one physician member shall be a person licensed to practice medicine in this state by the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners. Physician members licensed by the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision shall be members of the Oklahoma State Medical Association. One physician member shall be a diplomate of the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology or be similarly qualified.
- B. 1. The term of office of one member shall expire on June 30, 1964, and each nine (9) years thereafter, and such member shall be a resident of one of the following counties and shall have been a resident of one or more of such counties for not less than five (5) years immediately preceding such member's appointment: Creek, Lincoln, Okfuskee, Seminole, Pottawatomie, Pontotoc, Hughes, Johnston, and Coal.
- 2. The term of office of one member shall expire on June 30,
 19 1965, and each nine (9) years thereafter, and such member shall be a
 20 resident of one of the following counties and shall have been a
 21 resident of one or more of such counties for not less than five (5)
 22 years immediately preceding such member's appointment: Blaine,
 23 Kingfisher, Canadian, Caddo, Grady, Comanche, Stephens, Jefferson,
 24 and Cotton.

3. The term of office of one member shall expire on June 30, 1966, and each nine (9) years thereafter, and such member shall be a resident of one of the following counties and shall have been a resident of one or more of such counties for not less than five (5) years immediately preceding such member's appointment: Le Flore, Latimer, Pittsburg, Atoka, Pushmataha, McCurtain, Choctaw, Bryan, Marshall, Carter, and Love.

- 4. The term of office of one member shall expire on June 30,
 1967, and each nine (9) years thereafter, and such member shall be a
 10 resident of one of the following counties and shall have been a
 11 resident of one or more of such counties for not less than five (5)
 12 years immediately preceding such member's appointment: Cimarron,
 13 Texas, Beaver, Harper, Woodward, Woods, Major, Alfalfa, Grant,
 14 Garfield, Kay, and Noble.
 - 5. The term of office of one member shall expire on June 30, 1968, and each nine (9) years thereafter, and such member shall be a resident of one of the following counties and shall have been a resident of one or more of such counties for not less than five (5) years immediately preceding such member's appointment: Adair, Sequoyah, Cherokee, Wagoner, Muskogee, Haskell, McIntosh, and Okmulgee.
- 22 6. The term of office of one member shall expire on June 30,
 23 1969, and each nine (9) years thereafter, and such member shall be a
 24 resident of one of the following counties and shall have been a

- 1 resident of one or more of such counties for not less than five (5)
- 2 | years immediately preceding such member's appointment: Ottawa,
- 3 Delaware, Craig, Mayes, Nowata, Rogers, Washington, Tulsa, Pawnee,
- 4 and Osage.
- 5 7. The term of office of one member shall expire on June 30,
- 6 | 1970, and each nine (9) years thereafter, and such member shall be a
- 7 resident of one of the following counties and shall have been a
- 8 resident of one or more of such counties for not less than five (5)
- 9 | years immediately preceding such member's appointment: Logan,
- 10 Oklahoma, Cleveland, McClain, Garvin, Murray, and Payne.
- 11 8. The term of office of one member shall expire on June 30,
- 12 | 1971, and each nine (9) years thereafter, and such member shall be a
- 13 resident of one of the following counties and shall have been a
- 14 resident of one or more of such counties for not less than five (5)
- 15 | years immediately preceding such member's appointment: Ellis, Dewey,
- 16 Roger Mills, Custer, Beckham, Washita, Kiowa, Greer, Jackson,
- 17 | Harmon, and Tillman.
- 18 9. The term of office of one member shall expire on June 30,
- 19 | 1972, and each nine (9) years thereafter, and such member shall be
- 20 appointed from the State of Oklahoma at large, and shall have been a
- 21 resident of the state for not less than five (5) years immediately
- 22 | preceding such member's appointment.
- 23 | SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-104, is
- 24 amended to read as follows:

1	Section 1-104. A. The State Board of Health shall elect
2	annually from its membership a President, Vice President and
3	Secretary. The Board shall adopt rules for its government, and
4	State Commissioner of Health may adopt an official seal for the
5	State Department of Health.
6	shall hold such meetings as it <u>he or she</u> deems necessary. Each
7	member of the Board shall be paid travel expenses, as provided in
8	the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

- B. The Board Commissioner shall have the following powers and duties:
- 1. Appoint and fix the compensation of a State Commissioner of Health;
 - 2. Adopt such rules and standards as it he or she deems necessary to carry out any of the provisions of this Code the Oklahoma Public Health Code;
 - 3. 2. Accept and disburse grants, allotments, gifts, devises, bequests, funds, appropriations, and other property made or offered to it the Department; and
 - 4. 3. Establish such divisions, sections, bureaus, offices, and positions in the State Department of Health as it the Commissioner deems necessary to carry out the provisions of this Code.
- C. The State Commissioner of Health shall be appointed by the
 Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate. The
 Commissioner shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor and may be

2	Commissioner shall be determined pursuant to Section 3601.2 of Title
3	74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
4	SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-105, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	Section 1-105. There is hereby created a State Department of
7	Health, which shall consist of the State Commissioner of Health, and
8	such divisions, sections, bureaus, offices, and positions as may be
9	established by the State Board of Health <u>Commissioner</u> , or by law.
10	SECTION 4. This act shall become effective January 14, 2019.
