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BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 4002, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 323, O.S.L. 2012 (63 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 4002), is amended to read as follows:

Section 4002. As used in the Oklahoma Vessel and Motor
Registration Act:

1. "Boat livery" means a business establishment engaged in renting or hiring out vessels for profit;

2. "Canoe" means a light narrow ~~boat~~ vessel with both ends typically tapered to a sharp and point which is propelled solely by ~~paddling and includes similar craft such as kayaks~~ its occupants, using a single-bladed paddle as a lever without the aid of a fulcrum provided by oarlocks, thole pins, crutches or similar arrangements;

1 3. "Certificate of documentation" means a document issued by
2 the United States Coast Guard which is legal proof of ownership of a
3 vessel;

4 4. "Certificate of registration" means a document which is
5 legal proof of registration of a vessel or motor;

6 5. "Certificate of title" means a document which is proof of
7 legal ownership of a vessel and/or motor;

8 6. "Commission" means:

9 a. the Oklahoma Tax Commission, or

10 b. the equivalent vessel registration and licensing
11 agency of a federally recognized Indian tribe in this
12 state;

13 7. "Dealer" means any person engaged in the business of
14 selling, trading, renting with option to purchase, or attempting to
15 negotiate or negotiating sales or exchanges of interests in new or
16 used vessels or motors, or new and used vessels or motors, or any
17 combination thereof;

18 8. "Dealer agreement" means the agreement, authorization or
19 written contract between a manufacturer and distributor and a new
20 vessel dealer which purports to establish the legal rights and
21 obligations of the parties to the agreement, authorization or
22 written contract with regard to the purchase and sale of new vessels
23 or new motors;

1 9. "Designated successor" means one or more persons nominated
2 by the new vessel dealer, in a written document filed by the dealer
3 with the manufacturer or distributor at the time the dealer
4 agreement is executed, to succeed the dealer in the event of the
5 dealer's death or incapacity. If a designated successor is not able
6 to succeed the new vessel dealer because of the designated
7 successor's death or legal incapacity, the dealer shall execute a
8 new document nominating a designated successor within sixty (60)
9 calendar days after the date of the death or incapacity;

10 10. "Distributor" means a person, resident or nonresident, who
11 in whole or in part offers for sale, sells, or distributes a new
12 vessel or new motor to a new vessel dealer or who maintains a
13 factory representative, resident or nonresident, or who controls a
14 person, resident or nonresident, who in whole or in part offers for
15 sale, sells, or distributes a new vessel or new motor to a new
16 vessel dealer;

17 11. "Distributor branch" means a branch office similarly
18 maintained by a distributor or wholesaler for the same purposes a
19 factory branch is maintained;

20 12. "Distributor representative" means any person, firm,
21 association, corporation or trust and each officer and employee
22 thereof engaged as a representative of a distributor or distributor
23 branch of vessels or motors, for the purpose of making or promoting
24 the sale of his or her, its or their vessels or motors, or for

1 supervising or contacting his, its or their dealers or prospective
2 dealers;

3 13. "Documented vessel" means any vessel in this state which
4 shall have and carry on board the original certificate of
5 documentation in legible form as issued by the United States Coast
6 Guard or federal agency successor thereto. All documented vessels
7 shall be required to display a current State of Oklahoma annual
8 registration decal;

9 14. "Factory branch" means a branch office maintained by a
10 person, firm, association, corporation or trust who manufactures or
11 assembles vessels or motors for the sale of vessels or motors to
12 distributors, or for the sale of vessels or motors to dealers, or
13 for directing or supervising, in whole or in part, its
14 representatives;

15 15. "Factory representative" means any person, firm,
16 association, corporation or trust and each officer and employee
17 thereof engaged as a representative of a manufacturer of vessels or
18 motors or by a factory branch, for the purpose of making or
19 promoting the sale of his, her, its or their vessels or motors, or
20 for supervising or contacting his, its or their dealers or
21 prospective dealers;

22 16. "Hull identification number" means the serial number
23 affixed to the outside of the hull of a vessel on the upper
24

1 starboard side (right) corner of the transom (back wall) which is
2 assigned by the manufacturer or the Commission;

3 17. "Inboard motor" means an internal combustion engine mounted
4 inside a vessel which provides the transfer of power to move a
5 vessel through the water;

6 18. "Inboard/outboard motor" means an internal combustion
7 engine mounted inside a vessel and an external stern drive attached
8 through the transom of the vessel providing the transfer of power to
9 move the vessel through the water;

10 19. "John boat" means a narrow, flat bottomed square-ended ~~boat~~
11 vessel propelled by a pole, paddle or a motor less than ten (10)
12 horsepower;

13 20. "Kayak" means a light narrow vessel with both ends
14 typically tapered to a sharp point and propelled by double-bladed
15 paddles as a lever without the aid of a fulcrum provided by oarlock,
16 thole pins, crutches, or similar arrangements by one or more
17 individuals seated inside or on top of the vessel and facing the
18 direction of travel;

19 21. "Kiteboard" means a vessel, similar in appearance to a
20 surfboard, with or without foot straps or bindings, combined with a
21 large controllable kite to propel the rider and board across the
22 water;

1 22. "Lifeboat" means a vessel carried on another vessel in
2 excess of sixty-five (65) feet for use if such other vessel has to
3 be abandoned;

4 ~~21.~~ 23. "Manufacturer" means a person who manufactures or
5 assembles new vessels or new motors, or a distributor, factory
6 branch, or factory representative;

7 ~~22.~~ 24. "Motor" means any internal combustion engine mounted at
8 the stern of a vessel or placed inside a vessel which provides the
9 transfer of power to move the vessel through the water;

10 ~~23.~~ 25. "New vessel dealer" means a person who holds a dealer
11 agreement granted by a manufacturer or distributor for the sale of
12 the manufacturer's or distributor's vessels or motors, who is
13 engaged in the business of purchasing, selling, exchanging, or
14 dealing in new vessels or new motors, and who has an established
15 place of business;

16 ~~24.~~ 26. "Operate" means to navigate or be in actual physical
17 control of a vessel or otherwise use a vessel or motor;

18 ~~25.~~ 27. "Outboard motor" means an internal combustion engine
19 capable of being externally mounted at the stern of a vessel which
20 provides the transfer of power to move a vessel through the water;

21 ~~26.~~ 28. "Owner" means a person, other than a lienholder, having
22 a property interest in or title to a vessel or motor. The term
23 includes a person entitled to the use or possession of a vessel or
24 motor subject to an interest in another person, reserved or created

1 by agreement and securing payment or performance of an obligation,
2 but the term excludes a lessee under a lease not intended as
3 security;

4 ~~27.~~ 29. "Paddleboard" means a vessel similar in appearance to a
5 surfboard intended to be propelled only by its occupants, using a
6 single- or double-bladed paddle as a lever without the aid of a
7 fulcrum provided by oarlocks, thole pins, crutches or similar
8 arrangements;

9 30. "Paddleboat" means a ~~boat~~ vessel less than eight (8) feet
10 in length designed to be propelled solely by human power through a
11 belt, chain or gears;

12 ~~28.~~ 31. "Permanent number" means the distinctive and unique
13 number which:

14 a. the Commission permanently assigns to a vessel,
15 irrespective of any change of ownership of said
16 vessel. The permanent number shall begin with the
17 letters "OK", followed by four numerals, and then
18 followed by two letters, or

19 b. any federally recognized Indian tribe in this state
20 assigns to a vessel;

21 provided, the number is configured as prescribed in 33 C.F.R., Parts
22 173 and 174;

23 ~~29.~~ 32. "Person" means a natural person, partnership,
24 corporation, association, trust, estate or other legal entity;

1 ~~30.~~ 33. "Proposed new vessel dealer" means a person who has an
2 application pending for a new dealer agreement with a manufacturer
3 or distributor. Proposed new vessel dealer does not include a
4 person whose dealer agreement is being renewed or continued;

5 ~~31.~~ 34. "Purchase date" means the purchase date on a bill of
6 sale or the date of complete assignment of title by the current
7 owner;

8 ~~32.~~ 35. "Sailboard" means a vessel, similar in appearance to a
9 surfboard, equipped with a swivel mounted mast and sail not secured
10 to a hull by guys or stays;

11 36. "State" means the State of Oklahoma;

12 ~~33.~~ 37. "State of principal use" means the state where the
13 vessel or motor is used, is to be used, or remains for any period in
14 excess of sixty (60) calendar days;

15 ~~34.~~ 38. "Vessel" means every device, other than a ~~canoe,~~
16 ~~paddleboat or~~ seaplane on the water, used or capable of being used
17 as a means of transportation on water, ~~including but not limited to~~
18 ~~personal watercraft; and~~

19 ~~35.~~ 39. "Waters of this state" means and includes all waters
20 within the territorial limits of this state; provided, such phrase
21 shall not mean or include waters which are entirely owned by a
22 private person or persons, and to which the public is not permitted
23 access; and

1 40. "Water-thrust device" means a device tethered to the water
2 jet mechanism of a vessel in a manner so that the water jet of the
3 powering vessel provides propulsion for the attached device. Such
4 devices shall be considered a component of the powering vessel.

5 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 4005, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 Section 4005. A. A vessel or motor shall not be required to be
8 titled and registered pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma
9 Vessel and Motor Registration Act, ~~Section 4002 et seq. of this~~
10 ~~title,~~ if:

11 1. Such vessel or motor is owned by the United States, a state
12 other than the State of Oklahoma, any agency thereof, or any
13 subdivision of the state; provided, however, if such vessel is used
14 for recreational or rental purposes on the waters of this state,
15 said vessel shall be registered and numbered in accordance with
16 Section 4002 et seq. of this title;

17 2. Such vessel or motor is owned by a visiting nonresident and
18 is currently registered in another state. Provided that if any such
19 vessel or motor remains in Oklahoma in excess of sixty (60) calendar
20 days, such vessel or motor shall be registered pursuant to the
21 provisions of the Oklahoma Vessel and Motor Registration Act and the
22 registration fees due thereon from the date of entry into Oklahoma
23 must be paid;

1 3. Such vessel or motor is from a country other than the United
2 States provided such vessel or motor does not remain in Oklahoma in
3 excess of sixty (60) calendar days;

4 4. Such vessel is used exclusively and solely as a lifeboat;

5 5. Such vessel is used exclusively and solely for racing
6 purposes;

7 6. Such vessel is a commercial flotation device which is issued
8 a ~~permit~~ license by the ~~Oklahoma Scenic River Commission~~ Grand River
9 Dam Authority pursuant to the provisions of ~~Section 1461 et seq. of~~
10 ~~Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ the Scenic Rivers Act; provided, a
11 commercial flotation device shall be required to be titled pursuant
12 to the provisions of Section 4008 of this title; ~~or~~

13 7. Such vessel is a documented vessel provided such documented
14 vessel shall be required to be registered pursuant to the provisions
15 of Section 4016 of this title; or

16 8. Such vessel is a canoe, kayak or paddleboat as defined in
17 Section 4002 of this title except that such vessels, when powered by
18 any means other than human power, shall be titled and registered
19 pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Vessel and Motor
20 Registration Act.

21 B. Motors classified as inboard motors shall not be required to
22 be titled or registered pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma
23 Vessel and Motor Registration Act.

1 C. All vessels and motors which are owned by the State of
2 Oklahoma, its agencies or departments, or political subdivisions
3 thereof, or which, under the law, would be exempt from direct ad
4 valorem taxation, shall be titled and registered pursuant to the
5 provisions of the Oklahoma Vessel and Motor Registration Act.
6 Provided, all vessels and motors titled and registered to the
7 Department of Public Safety shall be exempt from all registration
8 fees.

9 D. All other vessels shall be titled and registered pursuant to
10 the provisions of the Oklahoma Vessel and Motor Registration Act.

11 E. At the request of the owner, any vessel exempt from the
12 title and registration provisions of this section shall be titled
13 and registered pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Vessel and
14 Motor Registration Act for the purposes of proof of ownership or
15 vessel identification. All title and registration fees shall be
16 paid by the owner of the vessel.

17 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
