14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 945 of Title 36, unless there is
17	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. As used in this section:
19	1. "Towing service" means any act which consists of towing or
20	moving a motor vehicle from one place to another under other than
21	its own power; and
22	2. "Emergency road service" means any act to adjust, repair or
23	replace the equipment, tires or mechanical parts of a motor vehicle

so it may operate under its own power; or reimbursement of expenses

- incurred by an insured when his or her motor vehicle is unable to operate under its own power.
  - B. No insurer may consider claims for towing services or emergency road service for purposes of determining whether to cancel, refuse to renew or increase the premium of a personal auto insurance policy regardless of whether such coverage is included in the policy or is an endorsement to the policy.
  - C. Nothing in this section shall prohibit an insurer from cancelling, refusing to renew or increasing the premium of the towing services or emergency road service coverage of an insured, if within a consecutive twelve-month period the insured:
  - 1. Files more than three (3) claims for towing services for any one covered personal motor vehicle or files more than five (5) aggregate claims for towing services for all of the insured's personal motor vehicles which are covered by the insurer; or
  - 2. Files more than three (3) claims for emergency road service for any one covered personal motor vehicle or files more than five (5) aggregate claims for emergency road service for all of the insured's personal motor vehicles which are covered by the insurer.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
