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1 Election Board shall conduct the data validation pursuant to this
2 section no later than June 30, 2019, and at least once every two (2)
3 years thereafter.

4 B. Persons who are identified in the data validation pursuant
5 to this section as potentially being noncitizens and who are
6 registered to vote shall be reported to the district attorney in the
7 county in which the voter is registered. Upon being notified by the
8 Secretary of the State Election Board about persons who are
9 potentially noncitizens and who are registered to vote, the district
10 attorney shall investigate and notify the Secretary within sixty
11 (60) days of the disposition of each investigation.

12 C. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall provide a
13 report on the results of the data validation to the Governor,
14 President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
15 Representatives no later than December 31 of any year in which the
16 data validation is conducted.

17 D. Personal information, including the name, address and
18 birthdate of persons included in the data validation, shall not be
19 subject to the Oklahoma Open Records Act and shall not be made
20 public except by an order of the court. The total number of
21 potential identifications reported to each district attorney shall
22 be a matter of public record.

1 E. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall promulgate
2 rules and shall prescribe materials necessary for the implementation
3 of this section.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2019.
