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[ motor vehicles - private vendor for marketing and
sales - special license plates and personalized
license plates - codification - effective date ]
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B. 1. The Commission shall establish by rule administrative fees for license plates issued and renewed under the provisions of

1 subsection A of this section. The administrative fees authorized by
2 this paragraph shall be reasonable but not less than the amounts
3 necessary for the Commission to recover costs to the Commission
4 associated with the:

- 5 a. awarding of the contract authorized by this section,
- 6 b. implementation and enforcement of such contract, and
- 7 c. direct and indirect administrative costs associated
8 with administering the provisions of this section.

9 2. The fees authorized by this subsection shall be in addition
10 to all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle
11 License and Registration Act, including the fees required by
12 Sections 1135.3, 1135.4, 1135.5 and 1135.7 of Title 47 of the
13 Oklahoma Statutes.

14 C. The contracted amount payable to a private vendor related to
15 the marketing and sale of special license plates shall only be
16 payable from amounts derived from administrative fees associated
17 with the issuance and renewal of such personalized and special
18 license plates.

19 D. 1. The Commission may approve additional designs and color
20 combinations for personalized and special license plates authorized
21 under the provisions of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, including
22 for special license plates that may be personalized, that may be
23 marketed and sold by a private vendor under a contract entered into
24 under the provisions of this section. Each approved license plate

1 design and color combination shall remain the property of the
2 Commission.

3 2. This subsection shall not be interpreted to authorize:

4 a. the Commission to approve a design or color
5 combination for a specialty license plate, or

6 b. the private vendor to market or sell a special license
7 plate with a design or color combination,

8 that is inconsistent with the design or color combination specified
9 for the license plate in the special license plate's authorizing
10 statute.

11 E. The Commission shall not:

12 1. Restrict the background color, color combinations or color
13 alphanumeric license plate numbers of a special license plate,
14 except as determined by the Department of Public Safety as necessary
15 for law enforcement purposes;

16 2. Restrict the private vendor from conducting reasonable
17 events or auctions;

18 3. Restrict the right of the private vendor to offer a variety
19 of plate categories with both personalized and nonpersonalized
20 patterns; or

21 4. Unreasonably disapprove or limit the ability for the private
22 vendor to offer plate terms that exceed one (1) year.

23 F. The Commission may cancel a license plate or require the
24 discontinuation or redesign of a license plate design or color

1 combination that is marketed and sold by a private vendor under
2 contract at any time if the Commission determines that the
3 cancellation or discontinuation is in the best interest of the state
4 or the motoring public.

5 G. To the extent fees collected under the provisions of this
6 section are in excess of the total amounts provided in subparagraphs
7 a, b and c of paragraph 1 of subsection B of this section and other
8 apportionment provisions for personalized or specialized license
9 plates, the excess amount shall be deposited to the credit of the
10 General Revenue Fund.

11 H. 1. A contract entered into with a private vendor under the
12 provisions of this section shall provide for the Commission to
13 recover all costs incurred by the Commission in implementing the
14 provisions of this section. Under the provisions of the contract,
15 the Commission may require the private vendor to reimburse the
16 Commission in advance for:

- 17 a. not more than one-half (1/2) of the Commission's
18 anticipated costs in initiating the contract, and
- 19 b. the Commission's anticipated costs in coordinating the
20 introduction of a new special license plate.

21 2. The initial term of contract entered into under the
22 provisions of this section shall be no less than five (5) years in
23 duration. Such contract may provide for additional terms at least
24 equal in length to the initial term of the contract.

1 I. As applied to contracts entered under the provisions of this
2 section, the Commission shall not:

3 1. Unreasonably disapprove or limit any aspect of a private
4 vendor's marketing and sales plan; or

5 2. Unreasonably interfere with the selection, assignment or
6 management by the private vendor of the private vendor's employees,
7 agents or subcontractors.

8 J. A private vendor shall not market and sell license plates
9 that compete directly for sales with other special license plates
10 issued under the provisions of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
11 unless the Commission and the agency or organization associated with
12 the special license plate authorizes such marketing and sale.

13 K. The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and
14 implement a system whereby motor license agents are permitted to
15 accept applications for special license plates authorized under this
16 section. The motor license agent shall collect and deposit any
17 amount specifically authorized by law, accept and process the
18 necessary information directly into such system and generate a
19 receipt accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license
20 agents shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of Title 47
21 of the Oklahoma Statutes for each year of registration of a motor
22 vehicle. The motor license agent fees for acceptance of
23 applications and renewals shall be paid out of the Oklahoma Tax
24 Commission Reimbursement Fund.

1 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as
2 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 331, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp.
3 2017, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
5 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
6 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or
7 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other
8 subject as provided by this section.

9 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
10 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
11 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
12 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
13 registered for the current year.

14 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
15 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
16 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.

17 The Tax Commission shall ~~annually~~ notify by mail all persons issued
18 special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary
19 information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure
20 upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission.
21 The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

22 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
23 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
24 applications for special license plates authorized under this

1 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
2 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
3 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
4 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
5 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
6 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
7 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
8 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
9 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

10 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
11 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
12 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
13 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
14 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
15 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
16 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
17 removed from the vehicle.

18 Except as otherwise provided in ~~this section~~ law, for special
19 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special
20 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission
21 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications
22 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax
23 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective
24 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null

1 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are
2 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
3 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

4 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
5 follows:

6 1. Round and Square Dance License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
8 round and square dancing;

9 2. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People
10 License Plate - such plates shall be designed, subject to the
11 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and
12 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

13 3. National Rifle Association License Plate - such plates shall
14 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
15 Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any
16 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle
17 Association;

18 4. Masonic Fraternity License Plate - such plates shall be
19 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
20 a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a
21 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated
22 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic
23 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for
24 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the

1 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in
2 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall
3 contain the Masonic emblem;

4 5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License
5 Plate - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for
6 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be
7 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's
8 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in
9 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall
10 contain the Shriner's emblem;

11 6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
12 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
13 ballooning in this state;

14 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plate - such plates shall
15 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member
16 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an
17 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a
18 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
19 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
20 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
21 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate
22 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
23 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

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1 8. Knights of Columbus License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
3 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of
4 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
5 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus
6 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights
7 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
8 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
9 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
10 Columbus emblem;

11 9. Jaycees License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
12 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
13 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
14 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

15 10. Kiwanis International License Plate - such plates shall be
16 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
17 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
18 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
19 consultation with Kiwanis International;

20 11. Certified Public Accountants License Plate - such plates
21 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
22 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified
23 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated
24 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a

1 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed
2 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public
3 Accountants;

4 12. Civil Emergency Management License Plate - such plates
5 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate
6 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons
7 applying for such license plate must show proof of official
8 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,
9 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or
10 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state
11 emergency management department head;

12 13. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
14 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and
15 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian
16 Conservation Corps;

17 14. Rotarian License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
18 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian
19 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license
20 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
21 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the
22 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate
23 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license
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1 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian
2 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

3 15. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
5 Tax Commission, by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and
6 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of the
7 Benevolent Protective Order of Elks;

8 16. Humane Society License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
10 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued
11 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
12 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
13 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

14 17. Oklahoma Mustang Club License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
16 by the Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this
17 state who is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons
18 may apply for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon
19 presentment of proof of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club.
20 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
21 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
22 personalized license plates;

23 18. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plate - such
24 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business

1 Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
2 membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in
3 consultation with American Business Clubs;

4 19. West Point 200th Anniversary License Plate - such plates
5 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
6 the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the United States
7 Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license plates shall
8 be designed in consultation with the West Point Society of Central
9 Oklahoma;

10 20. Oklahoma Aquarium License Plate - such plates shall be
11 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
12 the Oklahoma Aquarium. The license plates shall be designed in
13 consultation with the Oklahoma Aquarium;

14 21. The Pride of Broken Arrow License Plate - such plates shall
15 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
16 for The Pride of Broken Arrow marching band. The plates shall be
17 designed in consultation with the Broken Arrow Public School System;

18 22. Fellowship of Christian Athletes License Plate - such
19 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Fellowship of
20 Christian Athletes and issued to members and supporters of the
21 Fellowship of Christian Athletes;

22 23. Parrothead Club License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to members and supporters of the Parrothead
24 Club. The license plate shall be issued to any person in any

1 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven as
2 for personalized license plates;

3 24. Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition License Plate - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of the
5 Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition. The license plates shall be designed
6 in consultation with the Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition;

7 25. Electric Lineman License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
9 Oklahoma's electric linemen. The license plates shall be designed
10 in consultation with the Oklahoma Electric Superintendent's
11 Association;

12 26. Alpha Kappa Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Kappa
14 Alpha Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in
15 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha
16 Sorority;

17 27. The National Pan-Hellenic Council Incorporated License
18 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person
19 wishing to demonstrate support to any of the nine sororities and
20 fraternities recognized by the National Pan-Hellenic Council
21 Incorporated. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
22 with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Pan-Hellenic Council
23 Incorporated;

1 28. Organ, Eye and Tissue License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support and
3 increase awareness for organ, eye and tissue donation. The license
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with the State Department
5 of Health;

6 29. Central Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity License Plate - such
7 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to
8 demonstrate support and increase awareness for Habitat for Humanity.
9 The license plate shall be designed in consultation with Central
10 Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity;

11 30. Family Career and Community Leaders of America Incorporated
12 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons
13 wishing to demonstrate support for Family Career and Community
14 Leaders of America Incorporated. The license plates shall be
15 designed in consultation with Family Career and Community Leaders of

17 31. Delta Sigma Theta License Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Delta Sigma
19 Theta Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in

22 32. Omega Psi Phi License Plate - such plates shall be designed
23 and issued to any person who is a member of Omega Psi Phi

1 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation

3 33. Alpha Phi Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be

2 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
3 Tulsa Shock. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
4 with the Tulsa Shock organization;

5 61. Tulsa Oilers License Plate - such plates shall be designed
6 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
7 Tulsa Oilers. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
8 with the Tulsa Oilers organization;

9 62. Tulsa Drillers License Plate - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
11 the Tulsa Drillers. The license plate shall be designed in
12 consultation with the Tulsa Drillers organization;

13 63. Millwood School District License Plate - such plates shall
14 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
15 for the Millwood School District. The license plate shall be
16 designed in consultation with representatives of the Millwood School
17 District;

18 64. Booker T. Washington High School License Plate - such
19 plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
20 Booker T. Washington High School and shall be designed in
21 consultation with the Booker T. Washington High School National
22 Alumni Association;

23 65. Oklahoma Current State Flag License Plate - such plates
24 shall be designed to include the current Oklahoma state flag and

1 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the current
2 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
3 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center;

4 66. Oklahoma Original State Flag License Plate - such plates
5 shall be designed to include the original Oklahoma state flag and
6 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the original
7 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
8 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center. The plates shall
9 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
10 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Subject
11 to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Oklahoma
12 Original State Flag license plate is hereby reauthorized effective
13 November 1, 2015;

14 67. Tulsa 66ers License Plate - such plates shall be designed
15 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
16 Tulsa 66ers. The plates shall be designed in consultation with the
17 Tulsa 66ers Organization;

18 68. Frederick Bombers License Plate - such plates shall be
19 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Frederick
20 School District and shall be designed in consultation with
21 representatives of the Frederick School District;

22 69. 911 Dispatcher License Plate - such plates shall be issued
23 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for 911 dispatchers.
24 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of current

1 employment as a 911 dispatcher or sign an attestation that they are
2 a currently employed or retired 911 dispatcher;

3 70. Oklahoma Fosters License Plate - such plates shall be
4 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
5 Fosters Initiative and shall be designed in consultation with the
6 Oklahoma Fosters Initiative; and

7 71. Red Dirt Jeeps - such plates shall be designed and issued
8 to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Red Dirt Jeeps and
9 such plates shall be designed in consultation with Red Dirt Jeeps,
10 L.L.C.

11 C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)
12 per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
13 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
14 Registration Act. Unless otherwise provided in this section, the
15 fee shall be apportioned as follows: Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year
16 of renewal of the special license plate fee shall be deposited in
17 the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
18 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act
19 and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) per year of renewal of the
20 special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in
21 Section 1104 of this title.

22 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.4, is
23 amended to read as follows:

24

1 Section 1135.4 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
2 authorized to design and issue personalized license plates. The
3 personalized license plates shall be issued on a staggered system
4 except for vintage decals.

5 Personalized special license plates shall not be transferred to
6 any other person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer
7 of ownership and retained. The personalized special license plate
8 may then be used on another vehicle but only after such other
9 vehicle has been registered for the current year.

10 Personalized special license plates shall be renewed each year
11 by the Tax Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by
12 the Tax Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1)
13 year. The Tax Commission shall ~~annually~~ notify by mail all persons
14 issued special license plates. The notice shall contain all
15 necessary information and shall contain instructions for the renewal
16 procedure upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax
17 Commission. The motor license agent fees for renewals shall be paid
18 out of the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

19 B. Such plates shall be designed and issued for the following:

20 1. Any person in any combination of numbers or letters from one
21 to a maximum of seven;

22 2. Persons eligible for two or more of the military decoration
23 special license plates provided for in ~~Title 47 of the Oklahoma~~
24 ~~Statutes~~ this title. Such plates may be issued in any combination

1 of emblems. However, such plates shall only display up to three
2 emblems and shall also display any combination of letters or numbers
3 from one to a maximum of three;

4 3. Motorcycles in any combination of numbers or letters from
5 one to a maximum of six;

6 4. Persons eligible for Korean War Veteran license plates
7 provided for in ~~Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title. Such
8 plates may display any combination of letters or numbers up to three
9 on each side of the insignia or emblem;

10 5. Persons eligible for World War II Veteran license plates
11 provided for in ~~Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title. Such
12 plates may display any combination of letters or numbers up to three
13 on each side of the insignia or emblem; and

14 6. Persons owning vehicles which are twenty-one (21) years and
15 older are qualified to submit for approval by the Tax Commission or
16 a motor license agent a vintage but expired official Oklahoma
17 license plate which is twenty-one (21) years and older. Upon
18 approval of such personalized plate, the owner shall be issued the
19 annual registration decal which the Tax Commission or agent shall
20 direct to be affixed.

21 C. The fee for such plates shall be Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per
22 year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other registration
23 fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.
24 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the personalized tag

1 fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement
2 Fund to be used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle
3 License and Registration Act. Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) per year of
4 renewal of the personalized tag fee shall be apportioned as provided
5 in Section 1104 of ~~Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title.

6 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
7 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 331, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp.
8 2017, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

9 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
10 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
11 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
12 financial assistance as provided by this section.

13 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
14 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
15 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
16 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
17 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

18 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
19 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
20 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.

21 The Tax Commission shall ~~annually~~ notify by mail all persons issued
22 special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary
23 information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure
24

1 upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission.

2 The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

3 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
4 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
5 applications for special license plates authorized under this
6 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
7 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
8 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
9 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
10 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
11 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
12 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
13 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
14 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

15 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
16 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
17 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
18 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
19 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
20 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
21 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
22 removed from the vehicle.

23 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
24 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax

1 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
2 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
3 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
4 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
5 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
6 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
7 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

8 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
9 follows:

10 1. University or College Supporter License Plate - such plates
11 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
12 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
13 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
14 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

15 2. Environmental Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
16 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
17 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
18 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
19 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
20 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
21 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
22 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
23 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
24 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued

1 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
2 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
3 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
4 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
5 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
6 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

7 3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed
8 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.

9 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
10 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
11 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
12 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
13 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
14 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
15 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
16 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
17 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
18 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
19 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
20 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
21 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
22 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

23 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
24 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &

1 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
2 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

3 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
5 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
6 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
7 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
8 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
9 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
10 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
11 plates.

12 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
13 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
14 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

15 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plate - such plates shall be
16 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
17 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
18 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
19 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
20 the prevention of child abuse.

21 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
22 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

23 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plate -
24 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to

1 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
2 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
3 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
4 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
5 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
6 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
7 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
8 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
9 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
10 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
11 issued;

12 7. Oklahoma History License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
14 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
15 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
16 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

17 8. Historic Route 66 License Plate - such:

18 a. vehicle plates shall be designed to honor historic
19 Route 66, also known as the "Mother Road". As
20 provided in this section, an amount of the fee
21 collected for each vehicle license plate shall be
22 apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society
23 Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Route 66
24 Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma, and

1 b. motorcycle plates shall be designed in consultation
2 with the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, Inc. The
3 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
4 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Route 66
5 Association, Inc., for any licensing fees which may be
6 required in order to use the Oklahoma Route 66
7 Association, Inc., logo or design. The licensing
8 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma
9 Route 66 Association, Inc., of not more than Twenty
10 Dollars (\$20.00) for each motorcycle license plate
11 issued;

12 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
14 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
15 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
16 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
17 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
18 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

19 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plate - such plates
20 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
21 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
22 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
23 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
24 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in

1 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
2 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
3 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Personnel
4 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
5 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
8 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
9 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
10 Revolving Fund;

11 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plate - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
13 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
14 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
15 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
16 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
17 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
18 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
19 provide services to crime victims;

20 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plate - such plates
21 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
22 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
23 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
24 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of

1 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
2 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
3 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

4 14. Four-H Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
5 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
6 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
7 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
8 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
9 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
10 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
11 Section 1104.4 of this title;

12 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
14 by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in
15 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
16 person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag in the
17 Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an amount
18 of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section
19 1104.3 of this title;

20 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plate - such plates
21 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
22 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
23 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
24 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As

1 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
2 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
3 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
4 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
7 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
8 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
9 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
10 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
11 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
12 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
13 follows:

- 14 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
15 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 16 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
17 Education Revolving Fund,
- 18 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
19 Career Technology Fund, and
- 20 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
21 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
22 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
23 Oklahoma Statutes.

1 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
2 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
3 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
4 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
5 paragraph;

6 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plate -
7 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
8 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
9 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
10 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
11 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
12 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
13 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
14 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
15 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
16 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
17 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
18 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
19 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
20 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
21 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
22 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
23 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

1 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall be issued
4 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
5 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
6 shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. The Tax
7 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
8 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing
9 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America
10 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment
11 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars
12 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

13 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such
14 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
15 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
16 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
17 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
18 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
19 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
20 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
21 of this title;

22 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates
23 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
24 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and

1 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
2 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
3 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
4 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
5 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

6 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plate - such plates shall
7 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of pregnant
8 women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and
9 wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and
10 other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of
11 children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates shall be
12 designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the
13 Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Services.
14 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited
15 in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury for and to be
16 used by the Department of Human Services for the implementation of
17 the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act specifically for
18 created families;

19 23. Choose Life License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
20 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
21 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
22 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
23 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
24 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life

1 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
2 this title;

3 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
4 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
5 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
6 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
7 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
8 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
9 Section 1104.7 of this title;

10 25. Lions Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed
11 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
12 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
13 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
14 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
15 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
16 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
17 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
18 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
19 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
20 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
21 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

22 26. Color Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
24 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person

1 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
2 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
3 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
4 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
5 Section 1104.8 of this title;

6 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
7 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any

19 71. The Pride of Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
21 the University of Oklahoma Marching Band and shall be designed in
22 consultation with the University of Oklahoma Marching Band. The
23 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
24 licensing agreement with the University of Oklahoma or the

1 University of Oklahoma Marching Band for any licensing fees which
2 may be required in order to use the applicable logo or design. The
3 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Pride of
4 Oklahoma Fund at the University of Oklahoma Foundation, Inc. of not
5 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

6 72. Jenks Trojans License Plate - such plates shall be designed
7 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
8 Jenks School District. The license plates shall be designed in
9 consultation with the administration of the Jenks School District.
10 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
11 agreement with the Jenks School District for any licensing fees
12 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
13 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
14 Jenks School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
15 each license plate issued;

16 73. Bixby Spartans License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
18 the Bixby School District. The license plates shall be designed in
19 consultation with the administration of the Bixby School District.
20 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
21 agreement with the Bixby School District for any licensing fees
22 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
23 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
24

1 Bixby School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
2 each license plate issued;

3 74. Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission License Plate - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
5 support for the Oklahoma aviation industry and to promote awareness
6 of aviation and aerospace. Such plates shall be designed in
7 consultation with the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission and shall be
8 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
9 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Twenty-four
10 Dollars (\$24.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
11 Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission Revolving Fund, for expenditure as
12 provided in Section 91 of Title 3 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

13 75. Ducks Unlimited License Plate - such plates shall be
14 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
15 Ducks Unlimited. Such plates shall be designed in consultation with
16 Ducks Unlimited. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to
17 enter into a licensing agreement with Ducks Unlimited for any
18 licensing fee which may be required in order to use the Ducks
19 Unlimited logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for
20 a payment to Ducks Unlimited of not more than Twenty Dollars
21 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

22 76. Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate - such
23 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to increase awareness
24 of those who are currently prisoners of war or missing in action and

1 provide financial support for current veterans. The license plates
2 shall be designed in consultation with Rolling Thunder Oklahoma. As
3 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
4 deposited in the Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate
5 Revolving Fund created in Section ~~5 of this act~~ 1104.29 of this
6 title;

7 77. Woodward Boomers License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
9 the Woodward School District. The license plates shall be designed
10 in consultation with the administration of the Woodward School
11 District. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
12 licensing agreement with the Woodward School District for any
13 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the school
14 district's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
15 for a payment to the Woodward School District of not more than
16 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; and

17 78. Clinton Public School Foundation License Plate - such
18 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
19 demonstrate support for the Clinton Public School Foundation. The
20 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Clinton
21 Public School Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to
22 enter into a licensing agreement with the Clinton Public School
23 Foundation for any licensing fees which may be required in order to
24 use the school foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement

1 shall provide for a payment to the Clinton Public School Foundation
2 of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate
3 issued.

4 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
5 (\$35.00) per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
6 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
7 Registration Act. The fee shall be apportioned as follows:

8 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per year of renewal or any other
9 amount as provided in this title of the fee shall be apportioned as
10 provided or deposited in a fund as specified within the paragraph
11 authorizing the special license plate;

12 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall
13 be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
14 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and

16 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as

18 SECTION 5. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.7, is

21 Tax Commission or private vendor with whom the Commission has
22 contracted is authorized to design and issue special license plates
23 to any person that applies to the Tax Commission or private vendor

1 for the creation of a special license plate and meets the minimum
2 standards and qualifications specified in this section.

3 B. If the following standards and guidelines are satisfied, the
4 Tax Commission shall ~~issue~~ authorize the issuance a special license
5 plate to the person making application for the special license
6 plate:

7 1. The license plate is to:

8 a. show membership in or affiliation with an
9 organization, or

10 b. demonstrate support for an organization, group or
11 cause;

12 2. The license plate does not advertise or endorse a product,
13 brand, or service that is provided for sale;

14 3. The license plate does not promote any philosophy based on
15 prejudice or that is contrary to state civil rights laws; and

16 4. ~~Five hundred~~ Two hundred prepaid applications for the
17 special license plate are received by the Tax Commission or private
18 vendor.

19 C. The fee for special license plates ~~that do~~ shall be
20 determined in accordance with Section 1 of this act. If the special
21 license plate does not provide financial assistance the fee shall be
22 no less than Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per year of renewal and shall
23 be in addition to all other registration fees provided by the
24 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Unless otherwise

1 provided in this section, Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) of the fee shall
2 be apportioned as follows: Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special
3 license plate fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission
4 Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration of the Oklahoma
5 Vehicle License and Registration Act and the remaining ~~Seven Dollars~~
6 ~~(\$7.00)~~ amounts of the special license plate fee shall be
7 apportioned as provided in Section 1104 of ~~Title 47 of the Oklahoma~~
8 ~~Statutes~~ this title.

9 D. The fee for special license plates that provide financial
10 assistance shall be determined in accordance with Section 1 of this
11 act. Provided, the fee shall be no less than Thirty-five Dollars
12 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
13 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. ~~The~~
14 Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall be
15 apportioned as follows:

16 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to
17 the License Plate Special Program Assistance Revolving Fund created
18 in Section ~~7 of this act~~ 1135.8 of this title to be used in the
19 manner detailed in the application for the special license plate;

20 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
21 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
22 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

1 3. ~~Seven Dollars (\$7.00)~~ Any remaining amounts of the fee shall
2 be apportioned as provided in Section 1104 of ~~Title 47 of the~~
3 ~~Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title.

4 E. If a person applies for a special license plate that
5 provides financial assistance, the application shall designate a
6 state agency to be responsible for expending the funds generated by
7 the special license plate and the application shall designate a
8 specific public purpose for which the funds are to be used. The
9 application shall include an acknowledgment from the designated
10 state agency of their agreement with acceptance of the designated
11 funds.

12 F. Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
13 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
14 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
15 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
16 registered for the current year.

17 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
18 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
19 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.

20 The Tax Commission shall ~~annually~~ notify ~~by mail~~ all persons issued
21 special license plates of the renewal procedures prior to the
22 expiration of the special license plate. The notice shall contain
23 all necessary information and shall contain instructions for the
24 renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor license agent or the

1 Tax Commission. The license plates shall be issued on a staggered
2 system.

3 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
4 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
5 applications for special license plates authorized under this
6 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
7 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
8 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
9 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
10 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
11 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of ~~Title 47 of the~~
12 ~~Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title for registration of a motor vehicle.
13 The motor license agent fees for acceptance of applications and
14 renewals shall be paid out of the Oklahoma Tax Commission
15 Reimbursement Fund.

16 G. All special plates issued by the Tax Commission prior to the
17 effective date of this act shall not be subject to the requirements
18 and qualifications outlined in this section.

19 H. As used in this section, "person" includes an individual,
20 group, organization or not-for-profit corporation that is recognized
21 as such by the Internal Revenue Service.

22 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
