13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 724.5 of Title 3A, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. Entries submitted by lottery players to the Oklahoma Lottery
18	Commission for lottery-sponsored promotions and second-chance
19	drawing promotions offered by the Commission may be submitted using
20	a web application provided or sponsored by the Commission. All
21	entries for lottery-sponsored promotions and second-chance drawing
22	promotions shall be legally obtained from the Commission in one of
23	the following ways:

1	1. Purchase of lottery tickets from the Commission or a lottery
2	retailer;
3	2. Receipt of an entry-eligible lottery ticket from the
4	Commission or from a lottery retailer; or
5	3. Receipt of a promotional entry from the Commission or a
6	lottery retailer.
7	B. The process to submit entries to lottery-sponsored
8	promotions and second-chance drawing promotions provided by
9	subsection A of this section shall not be construed as illegal
10	Internet gambling activities. If passage of this section of law is
11	deemed by a court of law to allow any other form of Internet
12	gambling activities in the state, then this section of law shall be
13	rendered null and void.
14	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
