14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

17 The Department of Human Services shall contract to conduct a
18 survey of recipients and applicants of ADvantage waiver services to
19 evaluate the current eligibility determination criteria when
20 compared with a medical eligibility determination system. The
21 results of the survey shall be provided to the President Pro Tempore
22 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives no
23 later than December 31, 2018.
