2 this section the secretary of each county election board shall be
3 paid an annual salary to be determined by the following schedule.
4 However, the salary of a county election board secretary shall not
5 fall below the level of the April 30, 2003, salary, and the salary
6 of any person who is reappointed to the position of county election
7 board secretary shall not fall below the salary received in the
8 immediately preceding term, regardless of the number of active
9 registered voters in the county. ~~A county election board secretary~~
10 ~~serving on April 30, 2004, shall not receive a salary increase if~~
11 ~~said secretary is paid an amount greater than the salary indicated~~

16 above-specified salaries. Claims for ~~said~~ reimbursement shall be
17 filed according to procedures prescribed by the Secretary of the
18 State Election Board and approved by the Director of the Office of
19 Management and Enterprise Services. ~~Said claims~~ Claims for
20 reimbursement shall only be paid for actual expenditures made by the
21 county. The number of registered voters, for the purposes of this
22 section, shall be determined by the number of registered voters,
23 excluding inactive voters, in the county on January 1, ~~1979, and~~
24 ~~every two (2) years thereafter~~ of each odd-numbered year.

1 C. The provisions of this section shall not preclude a county
2 from providing additional compensation, payable from county funds,
3 to the secretary of the county election board; provided, any such
4 additional compensation shall not be considered part of the
5 secretary's salary, and shall not be reimbursed by the State
6 Election Board.

7 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
