L 5	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
L 6	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-890.7a of Title 63, unless
L 7	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
L 8	A. Each assisted living center shall annually provide to each
L 9	of its residents, no later than September 1 of each year,
20	educational information on influenza disease. Such information
21	shall include, but not be limited to:
22	1. The risks associated with influenza disease;
23	2. The availability, effectiveness, and known contraindications
24	of the influenza immunization;

2	4. The means by which influenza is spread.
3	Making available the appropriate and current Vaccine Information
4	Statement as provided by the Centers for Disease Control and
5	Prevention shall be deemed compliance with this subsection.
6	B. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require an
7	assisted living center to provide or pay for any immunization
8	against influenza for its residents.
9	C. No person shall have a cause of action for any loss or
10	damage caused by any act or omission resulting from providing, or
11	the lack of providing, educational information pursuant to this act
12	D. The assisted living center's license shall not be affected
13	due to the providing or lack of providing the educational
14	information pursuant to this act.
15	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
