12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5051.6 of Title 63, unless there
14	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	To the extent allowed under federal law, any provider enrolled
16	in the state Medicaid program may bill the Oklahoma Health Care
17	Authority for Medicaid services performed up to one year after the
18	date the service was performed. If a claim is initially denied, the
19	provider may submit a subsequent claim up to one year after the date
20	the original claim was denied; provided, the provider may only
21	utilize this provision once per claim.
22	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
