11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1132.6, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 1132.6. A. In addition to other vehicle registration
15	fees specified by law, there is levied and there shall be paid to
16	the Oklahoma Tax Commission a fee of Three Dollars (\$3.00) upon
17	every motorcycle registered pursuant to Section 1132 of Title 47 of
18	the Oklahoma Statutes this title for use on roads and highways. The
19	fee shall accrue and shall be collectible upon each motorcycle
20	registered for use on roads and highways under the same
21	circumstances and shall be payable in the same manner and times as
22	apply to the registration of motorcycles for use on roads and
23	highways under the provisions of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
24	Registration Act; provided, the fee shall be paid in full for the

1	then current year at the time any vehicle is first registered in a
2	calendar year.
3	B. Revenue from the fee levied in subsection A of this section
4	shall be transferred each month to the Department of Public Safety
5	for deposit in the Motorcycle Safety and Education Program Revolving
6	Fund created pursuant to Section 40-123 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma
7	Statutes this title; provided, in no event shall the revenue
8	apportioned pursuant to this section exceed the 3-year average of
9	the total fiscal year amounts apportioned in fiscal years 2015, 2016
10	and 2017. Any amount in excess of the 3-year average shall be
11	placed to the credit of the General Revenue Fund.
12	C. The collection and payment of the fee specified in this
13	section shall be a prerequisite to licensing or registration of any
14	motorcycle.
15	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.
16	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
17	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
18	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
19	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
