10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
11	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-11-504 of Title 27A, unless
13	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
14	A. As used in this section, "auxiliary container" means any
15	bag, cup, package, container, bottle or other packaging that is:
16	1. Made of cloth, paper, plastic, including foamed or expanded
17	plastic, cardboard, corrugated material, aluminum, glass, post-
18	consumer recycled material, or similar material including, but not
19	limited to, coated or laminated materials; and
20	2. Designed for, but not limited to, consuming, transporting,
21	or protecting merchandise, food or beverages from, or at, a food
22	service facility or retail facility.

1	B. Except for subsection D of this section, no political
2	subdivision shall restrict, tax, prohibit or issue any ordinance
3	regulating the use, disposition or sale of auxiliary containers.
4	C. Nothing in this section shall prohibit or limit any county
5	or municipal ordinance or agreement regarding a recycling program or
6	the disposal of solid waste.
7	D. Subsection B of this section shall not apply to the use of
8	auxiliary containers on property owned by a county or municipality.
9	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
11	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
