An Act relating to memorial highway designations; designating the Robert B. Robison Memorial Highway; requiring certain markers; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.269 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The portion of SH-66 in Rogers County beginning at the intersection of County Road S4110 extending north to the intersection of Fisher Road in the Town of Verdigris shall be designated as the "Robert B. Robison Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
