 - 1. Prevent, restrict or discourage any lender authorized and licensed to make loans under Chapter 57 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes from lending in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 57 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
 - 2. Prevent, restrict or discourage any lender authorized and licensed to make loans under Chapter 57 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes from operating in any location properly zoned for such commercial activities; and
 - 3. Create disincentives for any lender authorized and licensed to make loans under Chapter 57 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes
