BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 230.79 of Title 56, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Contingent upon available state funding, the Department of Human Services shall explore and recommend technological enhancements necessary to support Oklahoma's education and training programs for recipients of the Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Program (TANF). Such enhancements may include creation of an online self-service portal allowing consumers to retain responsibility for periodically reporting on their employment, education, training and job activities.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
