



1        2. Three members who are members of the House of  
2 Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the House of  
3 Representatives;

4        3. One member who represents a statewide association of school  
5 board members, appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;

6        4. One member who represents a statewide organization that  
7 represents school administrators, appointed by the Speaker of the  
8 House of Representatives;

9        5. One member who is a financial officer for a school district  
10 with an average daily membership (ADM) of one thousand (1,000)  
11 students or less, appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the  
12 Senate;

13       6. One member who is a financial officer for a school district  
14 with an ADM of more than one thousand (1,000) students but less than  
15 two thousand five hundred (2,500) students, appointed by the Speaker  
16 of the House of Representatives;

17       7. One member who is a financial officer for a school district  
18 with an ADM of more than two thousand five hundred (2,500) students  
19 but less than ten thousand (10,000) students, appointed by the  
20 President Pro Tempore of the Senate;

21       8. One member who is a financial officer for a school district  
22 with an ADM of more than ten thousand (10,000) students, appointed  
23 by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and

1        9. One member who is appointed by the Superintendent of Public  
2 Instruction.

3        The co-chairs of the task force shall be a member of the Senate  
4 selected by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and a member of  
5 the House of Representatives selected by the Speaker of the House of  
6 Representatives.

7        C. Appointments to the task force shall be made within thirty  
8 (30) days after the effective date of this act. The task force  
9 shall conduct an organizational meeting not later than August 31,  
10 2017.

11       D. A quorum of the task force shall be required to approve any  
12 final action of the task force. For purposes of this section, seven  
13 members shall constitute a quorum.

14       E. The task force may meet as often as may be required in order  
15 to perform the duties imposed upon it.

16       F. The meetings of the task force shall be subject to the  
17 Oklahoma Open Meeting Act.

18       G. Members of the task force shall receive no compensation or  
19 travel reimbursement.

20       H. Staff support shall be provided by the State Department of  
21 Education.

22       I. The task force shall submit a report of its findings and  
23 recommendations by December 31, 2017, to the Governor, the President  
24 Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of

Representatives and the chairs of the education committees of the Senate and the House of Representatives.
