12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 205.7 of Title 68, unless there
14	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to require
16	employees of the Commission in positions that have access to Federal
17	Tax Information and data to supply all information and documentation
18	required in order to be subjected to a criminal history search by
19	the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, as well as be
20	fingerprinted for submission of the fingerprints through the
21	Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to the Federal Bureau of
22	Investigation for a national criminal history check. The Commission
23	shall be the recipient of the results of the record check. In
24	accordance with Section 150.9 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
