11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 43A O.S. 2011, Section 3-111, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 3-111. A. The provisions of this section shall not
15	become effective until funding to implement this section is
16	authorized by the Legislature.
17	B. Except as provided in subsection C of this section, the
18	land, and all buildings and equipment attached thereto, at Northwest
19	Center for Behavioral Health at Fort Supply, Oklahoma, shall be
20	transferred from the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse
21	Services to the Department of Corrections. The transfer shall be of
22	surface rights only and all interest in mineral rights shall be
23	retained by the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse
24	Services. The transferred land shall be used for a correctional

1 institution to incarcerate prisoners of minimum security 2 classification.

C. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services shall retain the following land, all buildings and equipment attached thereto, which shall comprise Northwest Center for Behavioral Health:

Beginning at a point 732 ft. North and 33.0 ft. 1	E. The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services
2	and the Department of Corrections jointly shall provide fire
3	fighting services for Northwest Center for Behavioral Health, the
4	correctional institution at Fort Supply, Oklahoma, and the
5	surrounding community.
6	F. All official records pertaining to the operation of
7	Northwest Center for Behavioral Health shall be retained by the
8	Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services. All
9	inventory not needed for the operation of Northwest Center for
10	Behavioral Health shall be transferred to the Department of
11	Corrections.
12	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
