L2	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
L3	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1385 of Title 74, unless there
L 4	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
L5	A. Each agency, board, commission or other entity of state
L 6	government may adopt policies permitting employees to use leave
L7	accrued pursuant to Section 840-2.20 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
L8	Statutes for the purposes of physical fitness and wellness.
L 9	B. The provisions of this section shall:
20	1. Be eligible only for full-time equivalent employees;
21	2. Contingent upon approval by the employees' immediate
22	supervisor or agency director; and
23	3. Be limited to no more than five (5) hours per week.

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1	C. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
2	Services shall promulgate rules for forms and procedures for each
3	agency to implement the provisions of this section.
