An Act relating to state employees; permitting agencies to adopt certain policies relating to physical fitness; specifying eligibility; providing certain limitation; directing promulgation of rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1385 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Each agency, board, commission or other entity of state government may adopt policies permitting employees to use leave accrued pursuant to Section 840-2.20 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the purposes of physical fitness and wellness.

B. The provisions of this section shall:

1. Be eligible only for full-time equivalent employees;

2. Contingent upon approval by the employees' immediate supervisor or agency director; and

3. Be limited to no more than five (5) hours per week.

1 C. The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
2 Services shall promulgate rules for forms and procedures for each  
3 agency to implement the provisions of this section.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective in accordance with  
5 the provision of Section 58 of Article V of the Oklahoma  
6 Constitution.
