[Joint Resolution - Oklahoma Constitution - Revenue
Replacement Endowment Fund - ballot title - filing]

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
1ST SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution by adding a new Section 44 to Article X to read as follows:

Section 44. A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury an endowment fund to be designated the "Revenue Replacement Endowment Fund" to support the operation of state government. The endowment fund principal shall consist of annual deposits of at least five percent (5%) of the total collections of the gross production tax for each fiscal year levied on the production of oil

1 and gas prior to any other apportionment of the gross production
2 tax, income and investment return on endowment fund principal, and
3 any other deposits and apportionments from other sources as may be
4 provided by law. The Legislature may direct that any amount above
5 five percent (5%) be deposited for a fiscal year. Funds deposited
6 in the endowment fund shall be invested in the types of instruments
7 in which the State Treasurer is authorized by law to invest.

8 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
9 fund to be designated the "Revenue Replacement Revolving Fund". The
10 fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
11 limitations, and shall consist of deposits from the Revenue
12 Replacement Endowment Fund and any other deposits as the Legislature
13 may direct. Subject to the provisions of this subsection, all funds
14 accruing to the credit of the revolving fund are hereby appropriated
15 and may be budgeted and expended for fiscal years beginning July 1,
16 2017, in the same manner as the General Revenue Fund is expended;
17 provided, no monies in the revolving fund may be used for debt
18 service payments due on bonds or other financing instruments issued
19 by the State of Oklahoma, counties, municipalities, authorities,
20 commissions, political subdivisions or any other governmental
21 entities.

22 C. Beginning on July 1, 2018, and on July 1 every year
23 thereafter, no more than four percent (4%) of the balance of the

1 Revenue Replacement Endowment Fund shall be transferred from the
2 Endowment Fund into the Revenue Replacement Revolving Fund.

3 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
4 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
5 the following form:

8 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

9 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It will add a
10 new Section 44 to Article 10. It will create an endowment fund
11 to be used for state government expenses. At least five
12 percent (5%) of the gross production tax will fund the
13 endowment fund every year. The funds will be invested. Every
14 year no more than four percent (4%) of the funds in the
15 endowment fund will be taken out. This amount will go to a
16 fund that can be spent on state government like general
17 revenue. However, it cannot be spent on debt service on bonds.
