6	A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State
7	to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Section 57 of
8	Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution; clarifying modification of the Constitution using one general
9	subject; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

12	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
13	1ST SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
14	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
15	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
16	the following proposed amendment to Section 57 of Article V of the
17	Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows:
18	Section 57.
19	Every act of the Legislature shall embrace but one subject,
20	which shall be clearly expressed in its title No proposal for the
21	amendment or alteration of this Constitution shall embrace more than
22	one general subject, except general appropriation bills, general
23	revenue bills, and bills adopting a code, digest, or revision of
24	statutes; and no law shall be revived, amended, or the provisions

1	thereof extended or conferred, by reference to its title only; but
2	so much thereof as is revived, amended, extended, or conferred shall
3	be re-enacted and published at length: Provided, That if any
4	subject be embraced in any act contrary to the provisions of this
5	section, such act shall be void only as to so much of the laws as
6	may not be expressed in the title thereof.
7	SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
8	amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this act shall be in the
9	following form:
10	BALLOT TITLE
11	Legislative Referendum No State Question No
12	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:
13	This measure amends Section 57 in Article 5 of the Oklahoma
14	Constitution. The change clarifies how the Constitution may be
15	modified under one general subject.
16	SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED?
17	FOR THE PROPOSAL — YES
18	AGAINST THE PROPOSAL - NO
19	SECTION 3. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall,
20	immediately after the passage of this resolution, prepare and file
21	one copy thereof, including the Ballot Title set forth in SECTION 2
