[Joint Resolution - Oklahoma Constitution - cabinet
secretary - ballot title - filing]

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
2ND SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to Section 23 of Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution to read as follows:

Section 23. No member of the Legislature shall, during the term for which ~~he was~~ elected, be appointed or elected to any office or commission in the State, which shall have been created, or the emoluments of which shall have been increased, during ~~his~~ the term of office, nor shall any member receive any appointment from the Governor, the Governor and Senate, or from the Legislature, during the term for which ~~he shall have been~~ elected, nor shall any member, during the term for which he shall have been elected, or within two

1 years thereafter, be interested, directly or indirectly, in any
2 contract with the State, or any county or other subdivision thereof,
3 authorized by law passed during the term for which ~~he shall have~~
4 ~~been~~ elected; provided, neither the provisions of this section nor
5 any other provision of the Oklahoma Constitution shall prohibit a
6 member of the Legislature from being appointed by the Governor to
7 serve as a cabinet secretary, upon completion of the term of office
8 or upon resignation as a member of the Legislature.

9 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
10 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
11 the following form:

13 Legislative Referendum No. _____ State Question No. _____

14 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

15 This measure amends Section 23 of Article 5 of the Oklahoma
16 Constitution. This section prohibits members of the Legislature
17 from being appointed or elected to certain positions during
18 certain time periods. This measure would allow a member of the
19 Legislature to be appointed by the Governor as a cabinet
20 secretary, upon completion of the legislator's term or upon
21 resignation as a member of the Legislature.
