10	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
11	2ND SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
12	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
13	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
14	the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of
15	Oklahoma by adding a new Section 3.1 to Article VI, to read as
16	follows:
17	Section 3.1. Beginning with the General Election held in 2026
18	and in each General Election for Governor and Lieutenant Governor
19	held thereafter, one vote shall be cast for the candidates for those
20	positions of the same political party. The Legislature, by law,
21	shall provide the procedure for the joint nomination and election of
22	candidates for Governor and Lieutenant Governor.

1	SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
2	amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
3	the following form:
4	BALLOT TITLE
5	Legislative Referendum No State Question No
6	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:
7	This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It adds a
8	new Section 3.1 to Article 6. It deals with the Offices of
9	Governor and Lieutenant Governor. It would provide that a
10	voter would cast one vote for both of these offices. The
11	persons running for these offices would run as a team. The
12	procedure for the joint nomination and election of
13	candidates for those offices would be set by law. This
14	would begin in 2026.
15	SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED?

18	SECTION 3. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall,
