6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2011,
8 Section 24-100a, which relates to the Healthy and Fit
9 Kids Act of 2004; requiring certain committee to
10 establish a school wellness policy; requiring the
11 policy to address certain topics; requiring school
12 districts to integrate certain findings into certain
13 plans and report cards; requiring school districts to
14 develop certain plans to provide training; and
15 providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 24-100a, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 24-100a. A. This act shall be known and may be cited
20 as the "Healthy and Fit Kids Act of 2004".

21 B. Beginning September 1, 2004, each public school shall
22 establish a Healthy and Fit School Advisory Committee, to be
23 composed of at least six members. The Advisory Committee may be
24 composed of teachers, administrators, parents of students, health
care professionals and business community representatives.

1 A public school may combine the Healthy and Fit School Advisory
2 Committee with its Safe School Committee, established pursuant to
3 Section 24-100.5 of this title.

4 C. Each Healthy and Fit School Advisory Committee shall study,
5 ~~and~~ make recommendations and establish a school wellness policy that
6 shall be submitted to the school principal regarding:

7 1. Health education;

8 2. Physical education and physical activity; ~~and~~

9 3. Nutrition ~~and health services~~ guidelines pursuant to federal
10 regulation of school meals and snacks;

11 4. Health services; and

12 5. Equity.

13 D. The principal shall give consideration to recommendations of
14 the committee.

15 E. Each school district shall integrate key findings of the
16 committee into the district's long-term strategic planning, school
17 improvement plan or district report card.

18 F. To ensure implementation of the policy, the school district
19 shall develop a plan to provide training and technical assistance to
20 schools and address resources or pathways for health equity.

21 G. The State Board of Education shall adopt rules for
22 monitoring compliance with this section and is authorized to report
23 a school as deficient on the accreditation report for noncompliance
24 with the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
