14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:						
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 24-100a, is						
16	amended to read as follows:						
17	Section 24-100a. A. This act shall be known and may be cited						
18	as the "Healthy and Fit Kids Act of 2004".						
19	B. Beginning September 1, 2004, each public school shall						
20	establish a Healthy and Fit School Advisory Committee, to be						
21	composed of at least six members. The Advisory Committee may be						
22	composed of teachers, administrators, parents of students, health						
23	care professionals and business community representatives.

A public school may combine the Healthy and Fit School Advisory Committee with its Safe School Committee, established pursuant to Section 24-100.5 of this title.

- C. Each Healthy and Fit School Advisory Committee shall study, and make recommendations and establish a school wellness policy that shall be submitted to the school principal regarding:
 - 1. Health education;
 - 2. Physical education and physical activity; and
- 3. Nutrition and health services guidelines pursuant to federal regulation of school meals and snacks;
 - 4. Health services; and
- 12 <u>5. Equity</u>.

- D. The principal shall give consideration to recommendations of the committee.
 - E. Each school district shall integrate key findings of the committee into the district's long-term strategic planning, school improvement plan or district report card.
 - F. To ensure implementation of the policy, the school district shall develop a plan to provide training and technical assistance to schools and address resources or pathways for health equity.
 - <u>G.</u> The State Board of Education shall adopt rules for monitoring compliance with this section and is authorized to report a school as deficient on the accreditation report for noncompliance with the provisions of this section.
