SENATE BILL 1030

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the state Medicaid program;
directing Oklahoma Health Care Authority to seek
certain waiver; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1011.15 of Title 56, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall seek Medicaid waiver
authority to pursue modifications to Medicaid eligibility criteria
so that eligibility for the parent/caretaker group, relative to the
federal poverty guidelines, is reduced to twenty percent (20%).

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.

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
