B. Any Commission rules in effect on November 1, 2018, related to equine medications and drugs or drug testing of a horse prior to or during a race that are not based on peer reviewed and published scientific evidence, or any Commission rule that is similar to any rule, policy or statute of another state that has been successfully challenged in such state's court, shall be reviewed by the Commission before January 1, 2019, and made to comply with subsection A of this section or such rule may be deemed voidable.

C. Any person aggrieved by the Commission's enforcement of a rule in violation of subsection A of this section or deemed voidable under subsection B of this section may challenge such rule's validity by instituting a civil action in a court of competent jurisdiction.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
