13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-191 of Title 70, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. A public school district, a charter school sponsored as
17	provided for in Section 3-132 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes
18	and a virtual charter school sponsored by the Statewide Virtual
19	Charter School Board pursuant to Section 3-145.3 of Title 70 of the
20	Oklahoma Statutes shall be prohibited from using its State Aid
21	allocation or any other state-appropriated revenue to contract with
22	an individual or business entity to provide private extracurricular
23	lessons to students.
