11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1740.2 of Title 21, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Every person who buys or receives, in any manner, upon any
16 consideration, any firearm of any value whatsoever that has been
17 stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery, or having
18 reasonable cause to believe the same to have been stolen, embezzled,
19 obtained by false pretense or robbery shall, upon conviction, be
20 guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the
21 Department of Corrections for a term not to exceed five (5) years,
22 or a fine of not more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by
23 both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
