SENATE BILL 1121

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Health Care Authority Act; requiring Oklahoma Health Care Authority to provide notice in advance of provider audits; requiring Authority to allow providers certain amount of time to comply; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5025.1 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

When conducting a program integrity audit of any provider, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority Program Integrity Division shall:

1. Notify the provider in writing prior to the audit by a certain time to be determined by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board by rule; and

2. Allow the provider not less than two (2) weeks to comply with the audit.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.

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
