20	highway may run, and maintain the same <u>that crossing</u> unobstructed $_ au$
21	and in a good condition for the use of the public $_{ au;}$ and to build and
22	maintain in good condition all bridges and culverts that may be
23	necessary on its right-of-way at such crossing and in case. If any
24	railroad company or corporation fails so to construct and maintain
