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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 12 O.S. 2011, Section 760, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 760. If the words "appraisement waived" or other words
16	of similar import, shall be inserted in any deed, mortgages, bonds,
17	notes, bill or written contract, any court rendering judgment
18	thereon, shall order as a part of the judgment that the same, and
19	any process issued thereon, shall be enforced, and that lands and
20	tenements may be sold thereunder without appraisement; and such
21	judgment, and any process issued thereon shall be enforced, and
22	sales of land and tenements made thereunder, without any
23	appraisement or valuation being made of the property, to be sold:
24	Provided, that no order of sale or execution shall be issued upon

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such judgment until the expiration of six (6) months from the time
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    of the rendition of said the initial judgment.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
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
