13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1009 of Title 56, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. Subject to available funding, the Attorney General may
18	create a division under the auspices of the Office of Attorney
19	General whose dedicated purpose shall be oversight of the Department
20	of Human Services Office of Inspector General (DHS/OIG), as it
21	pertains to the investigation and prosecution of Medicaid recipient
22	fraud, waste and abuse.

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B. The division may review any case of suspected Medicaid

recipient fraud, waste and abuse referred to the DHS/OIG to ensure

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    that adequate and appropriate action is being taken against such
    cases.
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            If the division determines that the DHS/OIG has not taken
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    adequate or appropriate action against a suspected case of Medicaid
    member fraud, waste or abuse, the division shall have the ultimate
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    authority to investigate and, if necessary, prosecute the Medicaid
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    recipient.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
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
