13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:						
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be						
15	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:						
16	A. There is hereby created until December 31, 2019, a task						
17	force to study all administrative agencies in the State of Oklahoma						
18	that have legislative authority for police powers and authority to						
19	have employees who carry firearms as required by the scope and						
20	nature of their employment.						
21	B. The task force shall submit a report of its findings and						
22	recommendations by November 30, 2019, to the Governor, the President						
23	Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of						
24	Representatives, which shall include, but not be limited to:

- - 2. The training costs, staffing costs and equipment costs to each agency;
 - 3. How the affected agencies use the authority for policing powers; and
 - 4. Recommendations for improvement to the existing system.
 - C. The task force shall be comprised of seven (7) members to be appointed as follows:
 - 1. Three members appointed by the Governor as follows:
 - a. a member who is a representative of county government in a county with a population less than thirty thousand (30,000),
 - b. a member who is a representative of a state agency with police powers, and
 - c. a member representing law enforcement;
 - 2. Two members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate as follows:
 - a. a member who is a currently elected member of the Senate, and
 - b. a member who is a representative of county government in a county with a population of more than fifty thousand (50,000);

3. Two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives as follows:

- a. a member who is a currently elected member of the House of Representatives, and
- b. a member who is a representative of a state agency without police powers.

The chair of the task force shall be selected by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

- D. A quorum of the task force shall be required to approve any final action of the task force. For purposes of this section, four (4) members shall constitute a quorum.
- E. The task force may meet as often as may be required in order to perform the duties imposed upon it. The chair shall call the first meeting and all subsequent meetings shall be made at the call of the chair. The chair shall set the agenda for all meetings.
- F. The meetings of the task force shall be subject to the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act.
- G. The members of the task force shall receive no compensation or travel reimbursement.
- 20 H. Staff support shall be provided by the Governor's office, 21 the Senate and the House of Representatives.
