6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to school superintendents;
8 establishing maximum salary schedule for
9 superintendents; prohibiting school district boards
10 of education from entering into or renewing contracts
11 above certain caps; allowing the State Board of
12 Education to approve waivers to certain maximum
13 amounts for certain districts; providing definition;
14 providing for promulgation of rules; providing for
15 codification; providing an effective date; and
16 declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 18-114.15 of Title 70, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. Beginning with the 2017-2018 school year, a school district
22 board of education shall not enter into a new contract or renew a
23 contract with a superintendent after the effective day of this act
24 that is less than the minimum compensation or exceeds the maximum
25 compensation amounts provided for in the following schedule:

26 1. Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) to Sixty-five Thousand
27 Dollars (\$65,000.00) for the superintendent of a district or

1 districts with an average daily membership (ADM) of under one
2 hundred (100);

3 2. A maximum of Eighty-five Thousand Dollars (\$85,000.00) for
4 the superintendent of a district or districts with an ADM of one
5 hundred fifty (150) or less but more than one hundred (100);

6 3. A maximum of Ninety-five Thousand Dollars (\$95,000.00) for
7 the superintendent of a district or districts with an ADM of two
8 hundred (200) or less but more than one hundred fifty (150);

9 4. A maximum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for
10 the superintendent of a district or districts with an ADM of two
11 hundred fifty (250) or less but more than two hundred (200);

12 5. A maximum of One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00)
13 for the superintendent of a district or districts with an ADM of
14 seven hundred fifty (750) or less but more than two hundred fifty
15 (250);

16 6. A maximum of One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars
17 (\$120,000.00) for the superintendent of a district or districts with
18 an ADM of one thousand five hundred (1,500) or less but more than
19 seven hundred fifty (750);

20 7. A maximum of One Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars
21 (\$130,000.00) for the superintendent of a district or districts with
22 an ADM of three thousand (3,000) or less but more than one thousand
23 five hundred (1,500);

1 8. A maximum of One Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars
2 (\$140,000.00) for the superintendent of a district or districts with
3 an ADM of six thousand five hundred (6,500) or less but more than
4 three thousand (3,000); and

5 9. A maximum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
6 (\$150,000.00) for the superintendent of a district or districts with
7 an ADM of more than six thousand five hundred (6,500).

8 B. A school district board of education may enter into a new
9 contract or renew a contract with a superintendent that exceeds the
10 maximum compensation amounts provided for in subsection A of this
11 section provided that no state appropriated funds are used for any
12 amount above the maximum amount allowed.

13 C. The State Board of Education, upon written application by
14 the school district board of education, may approve a waiver of the
15 maximum compensation amounts for any district or districts with an
16 ADM of ten thousand (10,000) or more.

17 D. For the purposes of this section, "compensation" shall mean
18 any base salary an individual receives as a superintendent, teacher,
19 counselor, principal or any other capacity and fringe benefits.

20 E. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules
21 necessary to implement the provisions of this act.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

23 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
24 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
