14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1021.1 of Title 82, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Water
19	Sustainability Act".
20	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1021.2 of Title 82, unless there
22	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	The Legislature hereby declares that in order to efficiently
24	utilize and orderly develop the water resources available within

each geographic region of this state for the benefit of our citizens, the public policy of this state is to promote and support the planning and development of long-term water projects to achieve this policy through the use of programs and incentives that first seek to maximize the efficient use of water resources available within each region. The Legislature finds that prioritizing efforts to more efficiently develop our state's water resources to meet the needs of all areas within the state is consistent with the provisions of Section 105.12 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Provided, however, that nothing in this act shall be construed as amending the provisions of law pertaining to rights or permits to use water.

- SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1021.3 of Title 82, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
 - A. The Oklahoma Water Resources Board shall dedicate staff and resources, as available, to assist in the development of water plans and projects in furtherance of this act including, but not limited to:
 - 1. Promoting and assisting in the coordination of regional and local water planning efforts;
- 2. Providing assistance in the formation of voluntary water planning efforts;

3. Compiling and sharing information and providing available technical resources to assist in such water planning efforts; and

- 4. Coordinating potential federal, state, tribal, local and corporation partnership opportunities for financing and incentives to develop plans, technical studies and related projects;
- B. Contingent upon availability of funding and in addition to the general assistance described above, the Board may provide analysis or guidance regarding options available for development of water plans.
- SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1021.4 of Title 82, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Water plans and projects should be developed to efficiently maximize the use of water resources within this state, and should include, but not be limited to:

- 1. Voluntary consolidation and regionalization of existing infrastructure and water supplies in order to utilize limited resources most efficiently;
- 2. Maximizing existing reservoirs through activities such as raising dams, reallocating existing storage pools and the dredging of reservoirs;
- 3. Increasing water storage and minimizing transportation and evaporative losses of water used for agricultural purposes;

Managing or augmenting aquifer recharge rates through activities such as the land application or injection of excess fresh or recycled water; and Implementing conservation measures, such as system water loss audits, water reuse projects and system sustainability projects. SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows: The Oklahoma Water Resources Board is authorized to promulgate rules as necessary to implement the provisions of this act. SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018. SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval. 56-2-2454 СВ 1/18/2018 10:15:52 AM
