12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
13	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:
14	It is the intent of the Legislature to transform the State's
15	Medicaid program from a traditional fee for service system into a
16	system that provides budget predictability for the taxpayers of this
17	state while ensuring quality care to those in need. The new program
18	shall be designed to achieve the following goals:
19	1. Provide predictability and accountability for budget and
20	program outcomes;
21	2. Slow the rate of cost growth;
22	3. Create whole person integrated care;
23	4. Incent efficient administrative structures and increase
24	program efficiency;

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        5. Improve the quality of care provided to Oklahoma's Medicaid
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    beneficiaries;
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        6. Maintain access to care for the state's Medicaid population;
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        7. Create jobs and opportunities for Oklahoma's citizens;
        8. Coordinate across systems of care to improve outcomes for
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    Oklahoma's children and youth in state custody; and
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        9. Create new opportunities for providers through value based
    purchasing.
