6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to public health and safety; amending  
8 Section 1, Chapter 244, O.S.L. 2015 (63 O.S. Supp.  
9 2017, Section 5028), which relates to request for  
10 proposals for care coordination models for aged,  
11 blind and disabled persons; modifying procedure for  
12 initiating requests for proposals for care  
13 coordination models for certain persons; providing  
14 certain exemption; modifying authorization for  
15 promulgation of rules; establishing certain deadline  
16 for contracting; establishing length of contracts;  
17 and providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 244, O.S.L.  
20 2015 (63 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 5028), is amended to read as  
21 follows:

22 Section 5028. A. ~~The Oklahoma Health Care Authority~~ Office of  
23 Management and Enterprise Services shall initiate requests for  
24 proposals for care coordination models for aged, blind and disabled  
persons. Care coordination models for members receiving  
institutional care shall be ~~phased in two (2) years after the~~

1 ~~initial enrollment period of a care coordination program~~ exempt from  
2 the provisions of this act.

3 B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority ~~Board~~ shall provide  
4 assistance to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services as  
5 requested to promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this  
6 act section.

7 C. Before January 1, 2019, the Office of Management and  
8 Enterprise Services shall contract with eligible plans demonstrating  
9 the greatest ability to satisfy the state's need for value, quality,  
10 efficiency, innovations, and cost management, for a period of five  
11 (5) years, with an option to renew for an additional five (5) years.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
