6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; directing the
8 Office of Management and Enterprise Services to
initiate requests for proposals for care coordination
9 models for certain persons; requiring the Oklahoma
Health Care Authority to provide assistance;
10 authorizing promulgation of rules; specifying date by
which certain contracts shall be awarded; providing
11 for codification; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 81 of Title 74, unless there is
16 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall
18 initiate requests for proposals for care and coordination models for
19 aged, blind and disabled persons. Care coordination models for
20 members receiving institutional care shall be exempt from the
21 provisions of this act.

22 B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall provide assistance
23 to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services as requested to
24 promulgate rules and to implement the provisions of this act.

1 C. Contracts with providers to provide care coordination
2 pursuant to this act shall be awarded before January 1, 2019.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
