7 An Act relating to counties and county officers;  
8 establishing requirement for county officers to  
9 conduct certain background check; providing for  
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 271 of Title 19, unless there is  
14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Utilizing the Oklahoma State Courts Network, any county officer  
16 who issues a license applied for in a courthouse, shall conduct a  
17 free instant criminal history check on all applicants for all  
18 licenses applied for in a courthouse, to detect outstanding warrants  
19 for arrest. In the event that an outstanding arrest warrant is  
20 discovered, the county officer shall notify law enforcement  
21 accordingly. The county officer shall not utilize information  
22 obtained in the free instant criminal history check to deny a  
23 license to any applicant who is duly qualified to obtain the  
24 license.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
