7 An Act relating to the state Medicaid program;  
8 providing legislative intent; providing for  
noncodification; and providing an effective date.

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11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
13 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

14 It is the intent of the Legislature that the Office of  
15 Management and Enterprise Services shall initiate a request for  
16 proposal to transform the state's Medicaid program from a  
17 traditional fee-for-service system into a system that provides  
18 budget predictability for the taxpayers of this state while ensuring  
19 quality care to those in need. The new program shall be designed to  
20 achieve the following goals:

- 21 1. Provide predictability and accountability for budget and  
22 program outcomes;
- 23 2. Slow the rate of cost growth;
- 24 3. Create whole person integrated care;

- 1       4. Incent efficient administrative structures and increase  
2 program efficiency;
- 3       5. Improve the quality of care provided to Oklahoma's Medicaid  
4 beneficiaries;
- 5       6. Maintain access to care for the state's Medicaid population;
- 6       7. Create jobs and opportunities for Oklahoma's citizens;
- 7       8. Coordinate across systems of care to improve outcomes for  
8 Oklahoma's children and youth in state custody; and
- 9       9. Create new opportunities for providers through value-based  
10 purchasing.

11       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.

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
