6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to Medicaid; extending the bill cycle  
8 for the state Medicaid program to one year; allowing  
9 one additional year for claims initially denied;  
providing for codification; and providing an  
effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5051.6 of Title 63, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 To the extent allowed under federal law, any provider enrolled  
17 in the state Medicaid program may bill the Oklahoma Health Care  
18 Authority for Medicaid services performed up to one year after the  
19 date the service was performed. If a claim is initially denied, the  
20 provider may submit a subsequent claim up to one year after the date  
21 the original claim was denied; provided, the provider may only  
22 utilize this provision once per claim.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
