12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-145 of Title 29, unless there
14	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. Any Oklahoma resident who is a volunteer firefighter with at
16	least ten (10) years of service shall be able to purchase any
17	noncommercial hunting or fishing license or permit at a twenty-five
18	percent (25%) discount from the stated price.
19	B. In order to receive the discount a person shall provide
20	documentation from the fire chief of the applicable department that
21	the volunteer firefighter has met the requirements under the fire
22	department's constitution and bylaws and is a member in good
23	standing of the department together with a record of the total
