14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified

16	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. As used in this section, "auxiliary container" means any
18	bag, cup, package, container, bottle or other packaging that is:
19	1. Made of cloth, paper, plastic, including foamed or expanded
20	plastic, cardboard, corrugated material, aluminum, glass, post-
21	consumer recycled material, or similar material including, but not
22	limited to, coated or laminated materials; and

- 2. Designed for, but not limited to, consuming, transporting, or protecting merchandise, food or beverages from, or at, a food service facility or retail facility.
- B. Except for subsection D of this section, no political subdivision shall restrict, tax, prohibit or issue any ordinance regulating the use, disposition or sale of auxiliary containers.
- C. Nothing in this section shall prohibit or limit any county or municipal ordinance or agreement regarding a recycling program or the disposal of solid waste.
- D. Subsection B of this section shall not apply to the use of auxiliary containers on property owned by a county or municipality.
- SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
