14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 563.5 of Title 57, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	A. The Department of Corrections shall establish a prison
19	garden program. The program shall aim to teach inmates skills in
20	agriculture and food production in order to improve the outcomes and
21	reduce recidivism rates of those reentering society. Inmates shall
22	cultivate land within an institution to establish a garden and

harvest produce.

- B. On or before January 1, 2019, the Department of Corrections shall identify two (2) institutions that are best suited for establishing a prison garden program using the following criteria:
- 1. Institutions with the best physical characteristics to establish a garden; and
- 2. Institutions with the best capabilities to monitor and supervise inmates participating in a garden program.
- C. The Department of Corrections is authorized to contract with or collaborate with a private entity or organization that specializes in establishing curriculum for a prison garden program.
- D. The Department of Corrections shall develop procedures and requirements for those inmates wishing to participate in the prison garden program.
- E. Produce harvested from the garden shall be donated to a nonprofit food bank or pantry or sold with the proceeds used to fund the continuance of the program.
- F. The prison garden program shall be established no later than July 1, 2019.
- 19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
