- B. Except as provided in subsection C of this section, a person shall not intentionally or knowingly operate an unmanned aircraft at less than five hundred (500) feet above the surface over the private agricultural property of another.
- C. This section shall not apply to conduct committed by a person who has an easement and/or the prior written consent of the property owner or legal tenant or lessee of the property.
- D. Any violation of this section shall be a misdemeanor, punishable upon conviction by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed one (1) year, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- 12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
