18	Section 5-63.8. The original referendum may provide exemptions
19	for producers from payment of the state assessment if the exemptions
20	are included in full written form on the election ballot and the
21	referendum is adopted as outlined in Section 11 of this act.
22	A. Any producer who requests an exemption from collection of
23	any state assessment levied according to the provisions of this act
24	shall not be required to pay that state assessment.
