13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 641, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 641. A. All On or before July 1 of each year, all
17	persons legally licensed to practice osteopathic medicine in this
18	state , on or before the first day of July of each year, shall apply
19	to the secretary-treasurer of the <u>State</u> Board <u>of Osteopathic</u>
20	Examiners, on forms furnished thereby, for a renewal certificate of
21	registration. entitling such A properly renewed certificate of
22	registration shall entitle the licensee to practice osteopathic
23	medicine and surgery in Oklahoma during the next ensuing fiscal <u>this</u>
24	state for one year.

B. Each application for renewal of a certificate of registration shall be accompanied by a renewal fee in an amount sufficient to cover the cost and expense incurred by the established by the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners, for a renewal of the person's certificate to practice osteopathic medicine.

- C. In addition to the payment of the annual renewal fee, each licensee applying for a renewal of the certificate of registration shall furnish to the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners proof that the person he or she has attended at least two (2) days of the annual educational program continuing education conducted by the Oklahoma Osteopathic Association, or its equivalent, as determined by the Board, in the fiscal year preceding the application for a renewal; provided, the Board may excuse the failure of the licensee to attend the educational program continuing education in the case of illness or other unavoidable casualty rendering it impossible for the licensee to have attended the educational program or its equivalent.
- D. The secretary of the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners shall send a written notice to every person holding a legal valid certificate to practice osteopathic medicine in this state.

 directing the licensee to renew his or her certificate of registration and providing the renewal forms. The notice shall be sent at least thirty (30) days prior to the first day of July each year. directed by regular U.S. mail to the last-known address of the
