15	A party may petition or file a motion with a court of competent
16	jurisdiction to request a post adjudication evidentiary hearing to
17	present evidence of material facts not previously presented and
18	heard by the court. Such evidence may include forensic scientific
19	evidence that was not available to be offered by the party at trial
20	or that disputes forensic scientific evidence relied on by the state
21	at trial. At the conclusion of the hearing, the court may alter,
22	modify or vacate a previous judgment.
